This document should address all your questions and provide an overview of what to expect from a visit from Starr's Planetarium.

Our dome provides a theatre setting for 360° 4K immersive digital images with surround sound. It's not just a show but a fully interactive experience. Combining animation with real-time imagery, audiences will be actively engaged in a stunning 360° movie, taking a trip through the Solar System and onwards to the very edge of our Galaxy, and then coming back down to Earth to find out what's in the sky tonight.

We provide displays suitable for all ages and cater to specific needs. All our domes are wheelchair accessible, ensuring everyone can enjoy our shows comfortably and safely.

Our standard dome requires a large room, library or hall with a clear space of 6 metres by 7 metres and a height clearance of 3.1m. The only other thing we need is a power point. This dome manages between 20 and 35 (smaller) people.

Our Superdome requires a 10m x 9m area with a height clearance of 4.1m. It is suitable for larger spaces. The Superdome can accommodate up to 60 people, but we generally restrict the number to around 40/50 to ensure the comfort of adults accompanying children.

Other dome sizes are available on request.

Setting up times are 60 - 90 minutes, depending on the dome size and access to the staging area.

Our planetarium show can include;

- * A presenter-led Solar System & Galaxy fly-through.
- * A presenter-led 'What's in the sky tonight' display.
- * A choice of one of our 360° movies.

Each session can be run for approximately 20 - 60 minutes, including time to allow for the changeover of the audience. Session times and content can be modified to fit your timetable and needs. Our displays are suitable for all ages from kindy up to adult and are customised to suit the audience and requirements.
